Discounts and Rebates for Senior Members:

A discount is available for players still at College or first year out of College:

- Playing Men's Premier and Premier Reserve Discount \$120
- Playing Senior 3rd 7th (Senior A–C) Grades Discount \$60

Rebates are available for Tertiary students:

- \$120 for players in Men's Premier & Premier Reserve
- \$60 for players in the Senior 3rd 7th grades
- \$30 for players in Senior 1-day and Twenty20 full season grades
- \$15 for players in half-season teams (Twilight and Twenty20).

To receive the Rebate, apply in writing to the AUCC Club Manager and include a photocopy or scan of Student ID Card. Note:

- For 1-Day and T20 teams a maximum of 11 student rebates apply; for Twilight teams the maximum is 8
- Not available to players who are eligible for the College discount above

**Payment by Instalments

The AUCC Board recognises that some players in the Men's and Women's Premier and Reserve grades and the Men's Senior 3rd – 7th Grades might struggle with finding the full subscription in one hit. Therefore, this season our Board are continuing with option of paying at \$20/week, similar to paying e.g. weekly gym fees. To take this option, contact the Club Manager.

Limited Senior Playing Membership

This Membership category is specifically designed for players who can only play for the Senior 2-Day teams in the Club on an intermittent basis. It is particularly ideal for tertiary students who are studying outside of Auckland. Limited Senior Members can play for the Club on a maximum of 8 days during the season.

International and Provincial Players

To recognise the significant achievement and wider benefits to members of representative cricketers within AUCC, the annual playing subscriptions will be waived for any member that plays international representative cricket in the current or preceding cricket season (a refund will be made for any member who had paid fees in advance of their international cricket debut) or who has received a contract at regional level (Aces and Hearts) in the current or preceding cricket season.

"No Pay, No Play"

The Club has a "No Pay, No Play" policy which will be strictly followed this season. Any Playing Member who has outstanding subscription fees payable will forfeit the right to play for any Club team until full payment is received by the Club unless prior arrangements for payment have been made with the AUCC Club Manager and approved by the Junior Club Captain.

Non-Playing Membership

Non-playing members have access to all club facilities and will receive an invitation to all Club events. The first-named parent or guardian of a Playing Member in all the Junior and Youth grades, as recorded on the Application for Membership, automatically becomes a Non-playing Member of the Club and is entitled to vote at any General Meeting of the Club. Subscription: NIL. This membership is also open to any other person who wants to stay in touch with the Club. Such Members also have full voting rights at any General Meeting of the Club. Subscription: \$50 per season.

Life Membership Life

Membership is bestowed on members who have made a significant contribution to the Club either as a player and/or through voluntary services. Life members have full playing and voting rights. Subscription: NIL

Resignation and Refund Policy

Resignations should be made in writing to the AUCC Club Manager. Prior to the first playing day of the season, any Member who resigns is entitled to receive a full refund of subscription fees paid less an Administration Fee of \$20 to cover costs associated with enrolment which will have been incurred by the Club. Once the playing season has started, the amount of refund will be determined by the AUCC Board of Management.
